College Planning for Seniors

August

- Request admission, scholarship and financial aid information
- Review college websites
- Pick up ACT registration information

September

- Register for October ACT
- Mark your calendar with registration, admission & financial aid deadlines
- Request letters of recommendation
- Narrow college choices

October

- Take ACT
- Work on admissions essays
- Visit with college representatives
- Submit applications for early decision

November

- Finalize and mail application forms for December 1 deadlines
- Attend financial aid workshops
- Begin searching for private scholarships and apply for school scholarships

December

- Start developing a financial plan for college
- Apply for PIN for FAFSA
- Continue applying for private scholarships

January

- Prepare and submit FAFSA and other financial aid forms as early as possible in January
- www.fafsa.gov

February

- Attend the FAFSA workshop at FZN
- Have Guidance send mid-year (7 semester) transcripts, if required.

March

- Watch for your Student Aid Report (SAR) and make any corrections online
- Watch for financial aid awards from your college(s)

April

- Compare financial aid offers from colleges
- Decide on your college and notify schools of your decision (accepted and declined).
- Send required deposits

May

- Finalize student loan paperwork
- Sign Master Promissory Note

June

- Plan for college orientation and housing
- Follow up with Financial Aid office to ensure all paperwork is complete
